Day 1: Arrival Airlie Beach to Whitsunday Island

- » Depart from Airlie Beach Marina in the morning.
- » Cruise to Whitsunday Island, the largest of the Whitsunday group.
Anchor at Tongue Bay and hike up to the Hill Inlet Lookout for panoramic views of the famous [Whitehaven Beach](#). Spend the afternoon relaxing and swimming at Whitehaven Beach, known for its pristine white silica sand.
- » In the evening, enjoy a barbecue dinner on board while stargazing on the deck.



Day 2: Whitsunday Island to Hook Island

- » Once anchored, a short tender trip to [Manta Ray Bay](#) is rewarded with some of the best snorkeling and diving on coral reefs in the Whitsundays.
- » Explore the underwater world with snorkeling or diving at [Maureen's Cove](#) or [Langford Reef](#), known for its colorful coral gardens and marine life.
- » Visit the [Ngaro Cultural Site](#) and learn about the indigenous history and culture of the Whitsunday region.
Discover hidden waterfalls and whirlpools, offering the best views and postcard-perfect photographs. At dusk turtles often pop up beside the boat.
- » Spend the night anchored in one of the tranquil bays, enjoying dinner under the stars.

Day 3: Hook Island to Hayman Island

- » Cruise to Hayman Island, renowned for its luxury resorts and stunning beaches.
- » [Blue Pearl Bay](#), located on the northern side of the island, is a lovely expanse of bay with beautiful beaches and teeming sea life. Blue Pearl offers some of the best diving and snorkeling off Castle Rock and Dolphin Point. Enjoy water activities such as kayaking, paddleboarding, or jet skiing in the crystal-clear waters. Relax on the beach or indulge in spa treatments at one of the island's resorts.
- » In the evening, dine at one of the island's gourmet restaurants or the Chef will prepare a delicious meal on board.



Day 4: Hayman Island to Hamilton Island

- » Hamilton Island is the largest inhabited island of the Whitsundays. Celebrated for its famous beaches and majestic bushland, here you can relax in the turquoise shallows or explore unspoiled nature trails.
- » Tackle the [Hamilton Island Golf Club](#) course on its own nearby island, a Peter Thomson-designed 18-hole championship par 71, while kids may enjoy miniature golf.
- » Take a scenic helicopter flight over [the Great Barrier Reef](#) for a bird's-eye view of the coral formations and marine life. Enjoy lovely sundowners on board AIX while a beautiful evening is prepared for guests.

Day 5: Hamilton Island to Daydream Island

- » Wake up to a scrumptious brunch on board while cruising towards Daydream Island, known for its relaxed atmosphere and beautiful beaches.
- » Visit the [Living Reef](#), an open-air aquarium where you can snorkel and interact with marine life such as stingrays and sharks.
- » The crew will have a [spectacular beach BBQ set up](#), with a special lunch prepared on the hibachi grill.
- » Enjoy a sunset cruise around the island, sipping champagne and enjoying canapés.



Day 6: Daydream Island to South Molle Island

- » The Molle Islands are part of the Great Barrier Reef Marine Park and is known for its stunning natural beauty, pristine beaches, and abundant marine life.
- » The island's proximity to the GBR makes it an excellent base for snorkeling and diving excursions. Guests can explore vibrant coral reefs teeming with colorful fish, sea turtles, and other marine creatures.
- » Hike to scenic lookout points such as [Mount Jeffreys](#); enjoy panoramic views of the turquoise waters and lush greenery.

Day 7: Molle Islands to Airlie Beach

» Delight in a final brunch on board ahead of departure.
